#### **Procedures for Certification of Center Referees**

- Written test, two parts. 1<sup>st</sup> part – Rules / 2<sup>nd</sup> part – Medical
- Attend six (6) U.M.A.R.A. clinics.
- Minimum age, twenty-five (25) years or older.
- Rank of Black Belt and an active U.M.A.R.A. member.
- Regular attendance and participation as an official at U.M.A.R.A. events.

#### **To Maintain Status as Chief Referee**

- Participation in at least three (3) U.M.A.R.A. tournaments per year.
- Attend a minimum of fifty percent (50%) of U.M.A.R.A. clinics in a two-year period.
